How does an allergic reaction occur?

The body releases histamine in response to substances it recognises as 'foreign', such as pollen, dust and dyes. This can cause the common symptoms associated with allergic reactions such as sneezing, watery/itchy eyes, skin rash and runny nose. The severity of your condition will depend on how sensitive you are to 'foreign substances'.

What is Razene used for?

Razene belongs to a class of medicines known as antihistamines. Antihistamines can relieve the allergic symptoms by preventing the effects of histamine, which is produced by the body during an allergic reaction.

How do you take Razene?

It is important to follow the dosing on the pack to ensure you receive the full benefit of Razene.

- The usual dose for adults and children over 6 years of age is one tablet daily.
- The usual dose for children between 2-6 years of age is half a tablet daily.
- If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, seek medical advice before taking this medicine.
- Can be used in conjunction with Nasal sprays such as Alanase 50 and Butacort 50 where required for best results.

Razene is a Pharmacy Medicine used for the relief of allergies. Each tablet contains cetirizine hydrochloride 10mg.

Alanase 50 and Butacort 50 are nasal sprays used for the short-term prevention and treatment of hayfever.

Medicines have benefits and some may have risks. Always read the label and use strictly as directed. If symptoms persist or you have side effects, see your health professional.
